**EMBROIDERY AND CREWEL**

1. Each article must be made by a 4-H member who is enrolled in a 4-H Embroidery or Crewel Project within the current year. Embroidery items are to be framed, stuffed or hemmed as appropriate.

**EMBROIDERY**

- 140 Beginners - Completed article with at least 3 different stitches.
- 141 Intermediate - Completed article with at least 5 different stitches.
- 142 Advanced - Completed article with different color combinations and at least 6 different stitches.

**CREWEL**

- 143 Exhibit completed article that incorporates at least 4 different stitches.
- 144 Exhibit completed article that incorporates at least 5 different stitches; include transfer or original design.
- 145 Exhibit completed article that incorporates various stitches and color combinations; include transfer or sketch of original design.
- 146 Self-Determined

**SEPARATES**

- 150 Develop an exhibit showing 3 types of fabrics you learned about in this project, and at least one of the following - **required**
- 151 A two (or more) piece non-tailored outfit
