**RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

1. Exhibitors will be expected to display or parade their animals as directed by the Superintendent; to keep the stall assigned without controversy; to keep their animals in an attractive appearance; and to cooperate with the Department in every way that may serve to increase the educational value of the Show.
2. Exhibitors of dairy animals must inform themselves as to when their animal(s) will be judged. Cattle must be in the ring promptly on call and a failure to comply with the order renders exhibitors liable to be ruled out of competing.
3. Decorations with ribbons or ornaments previously won by the animal at a Show will be prohibited until after the awards have been made in their respective classes by the judge.
4. Exhibitors must have animals listed for competition on the grounds between 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. on Monday, August 8, 2011. (All such animals shall remain on the premises until after the conclusion of the Jr. Livestock Sale.)
5. The exhibitors will be expected to keep the space they occupy in a clean and sanitary condition and to remove all their equipment promptly as the superintendent may direct.
6. All Dairy Exhibits must be entered in their respective Classes prior to July 1.
7. Exhibitors may show more than one animal per Class.
8. All substitutions must be within the same breed and the same class as the original entry. No other substitutions will be allowed.
9. All cattle must be registered.
10. Entry fee \$4.00 per entry.
11. In-county herds will be limited to 20 head of cattle per farm.
12. Out of county herds will be limited to 15 head of cattle per farm.
13. Straw/bedding must be supplied by the exhibitor.
