Drivers must be 16 years of age and have a valid driver's license to compete.
Any driver(s) under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian sign the release form.

SPECTATOR ADMISSION (for both events): Adults - \$5. Children 12 years old and under – free. (includes both events)

RULES:

1. Cars Permitted:
 - A. Any 4 cylinders, front wheel drive, non 4-wheel drive non-turbo. Cars must be stock.
2. Cars Appearance:
 - A. Both front doors must be painted white!
 - B. Any lettering on the car must be done in good taste.
3. Car Conditions:
 - A. Cars must have working brakes on all four wheels.
 - B. All glass, headlights, plastic lenses, and plastic bumper covers must be removed.
 - C. All plastic door panels, headliners, consoles and carpet must be removed.
 - D. All sunroofs must be removed and replaced with sheet metal to cover the hole.
 - E. Must have factory gas tank in the original position. Gas tank must be secured through the trunk floor by wire or chain.
 - F. Battery must remain under the hood, in stock location, but may be protected by rubber or foam padding.
 - G. All unnecessary fuses must be removed.
 - H. Airbags must be disabled or removed.
 - I. Air conditioning system must be drained of all Freon.
 - J. Ignition switch must remain stock.
 - K. Roll cages are permitted but not required.
 - L. No down bars are permitted to the trunk'.
 - M. Only one door bar permitted on passenger side of car.
 - N. Hood and trunk must be chained down in one position.
 1. There must be a hole cut in the hood 12 inches in diameter, in case of fire.
 - O. Springs must be removed from hood and trunk.
 - P. Welding or chain must secure all doors.
 - Q. Drivers door must be reinforced by steel bar or pipe. Angled to the body.
 - R. Engine coolant must be drained and replaced with water.
 - S. All tires must be car tires only!
 - T. No studded tires.
 - U. Wheel weights must be removed from the wheels.
4. Safety
 - A. If your car catches fire the race will be stopped - you will be permitted to continue once the fire is out. If your car catches fire again you will be disqualified.
 - B. Drivers door must be padded
 - C. All drivers must wear full-faced helmet with shield or goggles.

D. Long pants and long sleeve shirts must be worn by all drivers, or driver's suits while racing.

E. Seat belts in working condition must be worn at all times while racing.

F. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES PERMITTED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS.** Anyone caught will be disqualified and escorted off the Fairgrounds.

G. Clinton County Fair is not responsible for damages to any personal property or vehicles while in the Pits area.

 - B. Vans must be stock. No rear wheel drive vans permitted.
- 2 Vans Appearance
 - A. Vans must have working brakes on all four wheels.
 - B. All glass, headlights, and plastic lenses must be removed.
 - C. All plastic door panels, headliners, consoles and carpet must be removed.
 - D. All sunroofs must be removed and replaced with sheet metal to cover the hole.
 - E. Must have factory gas tank in the original position. Gas tank must be secured through the trunk floor by wire or chain.
 - F. Battery must remain under the hood, in stock location, but may be protected by rubber or foam padding.
 - G. All unnecessary fuses must be removed.
 - H. Airbags must be disabled or removed
