GARDEN TRACTOR PULLING

GENERAL RULES (Applies to all classes)

1. A tractor may pull only once in each class.
2. Any tractor or puller found to be unsafe or illegal may be disqualified or barred from hooking (on or off the track).
3. No use of alcoholic beverages will be permitted!
4. Driver must maintain control at all times. Any unsafe practice (i.e. leaning over the hood or jumping on the seat) will result in disqualification.
5. Contact point of the tractor must remain in-bounds at all times. Contact with the white line is out-of-bounds.
6. Factory safety shrouds **MUST** be in place or homemade shrouds of same or better quality especially around drive clutch or drive belt and mower clutch.
7. First puller in each class is the test puller and has the option of dropping to the third position if the first hook is not taken.
8. The flag man's decision is final while on the track.
9. All pulls to be started from a tight hitch, no jerking.
10. Two attempts will be given within a 30' safety zone.
11. All rules will be interpreted by the tech crew. Any unforeseen problems or oversights will be ruled on by the tech crew with their ruling being final.
12. Any and all protests must be made by drivers in the same class and will result in both the protested tractor and the protestors tractor being checked. The protest must be made before the tractor leaves the track.
13. Any part falling off of the tractor after being hooked and until the tractor is unhooked will result in disqualification. It is suggested that all weights be secured.
14. No youth allowed in the adult lawn stock class. Youth class is 10-15 years old. Youth tractors fall in the lawn stock rules.
15. No weights to extend past rear tires.
16. ALL tractors must be equipped with wheelie bars.

LAWN STOCK

Classes: 1000 and 1100 pounds

1. Tractor engine horsepower may not exceed 16 h.p. Twin cylinders are allowed.
2. Tractor must have stock hood, grille, frame, axles, etc. and be in stock appearance. Lift arm, plow bracket or mower bracket must be on the tractor.
3. No aluminum rims, front or rear. Front tires should stock size.
4. Maximum tire size 23x10.50x12. Unless factory equipped with larger size. ex: Case, Power King, etc. with 8x15 or 16. A factory brochure or dealer invoice must be presented as proof, if not a Case, Power King., etc.
5. All engine parts must be stock that make. Except - allowed straight pipe and aftermarket air filter.
6. NO cut tires.
7. 10" drawbar height, stationary in all directions.

8. No gas pedals, velocity stacks or electric fuel pumps allowed.
9. Engine must have an operating governor - 4000 RPM's max.
10. Pump gas only. No alcohol.

STOCK ALTERED/MODIFIED STOCK

Classes: 1000 and 1100 pounds

1. Tractor must be regular manufacturer's model. Stock wheel base.
2. 10" Drawbar height, stationary in all directions.
3. Maximum tire size: 23x10.50x12.
4. NO cut tires.
5. 14 h.p. maximum, single cylinder OEM production engines.
6. Steel or Aluminum flywheels only. No cast iron.
7. Recommended to have head strap.
8. Stock style carburetors - velocity stacks permitted.
9. Pump gas only. No alcohol.
10. Recommended to have a fire extinguisher mounted to the tractor.

OPEN STOCK

1. This Class is open to any tractor that does not fit into the Lawn Stock or Stock Altered Classes.
2. Single or twin cylinder air cooled engines – any horsepower
3. Max. tire size: 26x12x12 – any cut allowed.
4. 10" draw bar height, stationary in all directions
5. Steel or aluminum flywheels only.
6. Must have head straps.
7. Altered wheel base allowed.
