Contestants may compete **ONLY ONCE** in any event and anyone behaving in an unsportsman-like manner will be disqualified. 1. **LOG ROLL** - Log will be rolled 40 feet. Log must hit stakes at end of course.
2. **CROSS CUT SAWING** - Each team must make one (1) cut through 18" round block
3. **JACK AND JILL CROSS CUT SAWING** - Team will consist of one man and one woman. Contestants will make one cut through a 10x10 cant. Any type saw may be used.
4. **AXE THROW** - Axes must have a handle of at least 24 inches and a head weight of 2-1/2 pounds. Axes will be thrown a minimum of 20 feet.
5. **LOG CHOP** - Contestant must chop through a 12" round block. Any style or weight axe is acceptable.
6. **SPRINGBOARD** - Contestant will chop two (2) board holes without cutting into prior board holes, unless judge gives permission. Block on top must be chopped from both sides.
7. **MODIFIED CHAIN SAW** - No restrictions on size or modification of saw. Chaps are required.
8. **SINGLE BUCK** - Each contestant will make one cut through an 18" round block. Any style saw may be used.
